BE STORM READY WITH FREE SANDBAGS:

To prepare for the peak of hurricane season, the City of Belle Isle is hosting a free self-serve sandbag program for Belle Isle residents **ONLY**.

- Do-it-yourself sandbag filling located at Wallace Field.
- **BRING YOUR ID:** City personnel will be there to check ID's and hand out bags. Supplies provided (e.g., shovels, bags, and sand).
- Must present a valid ID. Sandbags will only be provided to residents of Belle Isle.
- Limit 7 sandbags per household.
- It would be helpful to bring your shovel to speed uploading.
- Sandbags available for filling on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- While Supplies last.



HURRICANE SEASON STARTS JUNE 1—NOV 30.
