New Business

The motion was made by Kathy McCoy to keep expiring term members in place as well as existing officers. Lora Brannan retains position of Secretary and Holly Bobrowski to move from "acting" Chair to Chair. Motion second by Craig Huff and motion passed unanimously.

Proposal for a fall event was discussed and prepared for approval. (See attached)

Ideas for Veterans Day recognition was discussed. Large red, white and blue wooden stars with the names of active, retired and /or deceased service members to be displayed in front of City Hall from Nov. 9 through November 16th. Details to be finalized at next meeting.

Christmas Holiday events discussed. The committee is concerned about an event where social distancing would prove to be problematic. Possibility of a drive through event was discussed. The committee would like to do all possible to keep the Santa ride. Modifications were brought up to keep the event safe and to prevent crowds. Stops can be eliminated and additional streets included allowing more spacing of residents. Plush toys (comparable to last year) and a small candy bag can be placed in a cellophane bag to eliminate excessive handling. Minimal number of "elves" on the sleigh along with Santa. Committee members tasked with finding ideas that would fall within the CDC parameters and presenting at October meeting. Dates for Santa ride to be determined at that time.
