Recycling is required by Orange County Code. To reduce the amount of garbage in the recycling stream, JJ's Waste & Recycling encourages residents to "Think 5" by focusing on the top five recyclable items—plastic, metal, and glass containers, as well as cardboard and paper. The overall goal is to help raise awareness about good recycling habits.

Place only these recyclable items in the roll cart with the blue lid:

PLASTIC Bottles and containers labeled #1 -

#5. Lids or caps can stay on

**METAL** Tin, aluminum, steel, and empty

aerosol cans

**GLASS** Bottles and jars: remove lids or caps

**CARDBOARD** Flattened corrugated boxes

PAPER Newspapers and advertisements,

Paper bags, Junk mail, Magazines and catalogs, Office/note paper, Phone books, Cereal/shoe/drink boxes and

Milk/juice cartons



The recycling program can only recycle the materials listed and no other material should go into the recycling cart. Below is a list of materials that are particularly troublesome and should not be placed in the recycling cart:

- No plastic bags
- No food waste or liquids
- No pizza boxes or juice pouches
- No clothes, textiles, or carpet
- No hazardous materials or electronics
- No batteries
- No polystyrene/Styrofoam
- No plants or yard waste such as bagged or loose grass, leaves, or small branches
- No hoses
- No shredded paper
- No dishes, paper plates, pots, or pans
- No toys or laundry baskets
- No gift wrap, ribbons, or bows
- No hangers (plastic or wire)
