
Recycle dead alkaline non-rechargeable batteries at City Hall Shredding: UPS store at Hoffner Center – \$1 per pound

Trash Tuesday


Include the following with your regular trash

- Gift wrapping paper
- **AND** anything else NOT on the Recycle Wednesday list below

- Recycle Wednesday Cardboard
 - Paper
 - Newspaper / Advertisements
 - Office / Notebook papers
 - Magazines / Catalogs
 - o Junk / Unwanted mail
 - Cereal boxes
 - Aluminum cans
 - Steel (tin) food and empty aerosol cans
 - Glass Take the **CAPS OFF**
 - Plastic containers #1 − 5: Leave the CAPS ON
